The incumbent will be based at the Vaalkop WTW's and the primary functions of this post entail amongst others

- Repair or replace leaking pipes and digging of trenches.
- Removing and replacing damaged pipeline sections, testing system under pressure.
- Backfilling opened trenches to ensure compliance with maintenance standards.
- Installs new connections to provide water supply to new consumers.
- Take daily key meter reading for bulk consumers.
- Bulk water restrictions
- Disconnect or reconnect meters of customers on arrears.
- Install and replace bulk meters, taking old & new readings to ascertain correct meter reading and billing.
- Joins pipes by using couplings, bolts, fittings, and pipe sections composed of metals, such as steel, brass, and non-metals, such as PVC and asbestos to restore supply.
- Assemble and install valves to ascertain control of water flow in system, control opening and closing of reservoir levels.
- Conduct weekly pipeline inspection to report any system deviation and complete job cards for costing purposes and maintenance history.
- Maintains and clean reservoirs, manholes and valve chambers regularly or as scheduled to safeguard the public and the organization against losses.
