Magalies Water Completes Installation of New Section of the Bulk Pipeline on the Bospoort Supply Line and Resumes Operations

The work that necessitated the shutdown of the Bospoort supply line which subsequently affected various areas of Rustenburg Local Municipality and Royal Bafokeng Administration, for a period not exceeding 60 hours has been completed successfully ahead of schedule.

Communities that are being supplied before Bospoort reservoirs had their water supply restored last night at 19:30. Bulk water supply downstream of Bospoort reservoirs was restored at around 08:30. Customers are reminded that due to the nature of the work undertaken as well as the duration in which operations had been suspended, the system was subsequently drained. As such, it will take time for full water supply to be restored, particularly for communities in high-lying areas.

We understand the inconvenience of not having normal water supply for prolonged periods due to the necessary works and would like to thank communities for their patience during this shutdown. We continue to encourage communities to use water sparingly, until such time that normal water supply is sustained.
