## **Prepare Necessary Documents**

- → ID documents
- → Grade 11 and Matric results (if currently in Matric)
- → Matric certificate, if completed Matric and;
- → latest academic transcript or record on official letterhead or logo (if you are already at a tertiary institution).
- → Provisional acceptance letter from the university

The first four documents should be certified copies.

Bursaries are available to South African citizens who have achieved an average of 65% in Grade 12.
